Opportunity:

We are seeking a talented camp instructor to join our team in a leadership position and help us build our program beginning this summer with our Wild Day Camp Program. This program will run Monday to Friday from July 4th to August 26th – 9 to 4 pm.

The BMWS Instructor is required to independently supervise groups up to 10 with the assistance of an LIT (leader in training) and oversight from a program coordinator. He / She will have a comfort with riding a bicycle on different terrain, paddling canoes in flat water and hiking in the Beaver Valley area, be comfortable working outside in all weather conditions and be adaptable to instruct to a wide range of students (From ages 4 to 12) in an outdoor setting in a safe and fun manner. A means of transportation is required in order to travel to our various program locations within the Blue Mountains region.

Qualifications:

- High School Diploma
- Two (2) years of experience as a Camp Counsellor (preferably at an overnight camp).
- Standard First Aid & CPR certification – Wilderness First Aid an asset.
- Demonstrated experience in a leadership position supervising a minimum of 2 employees or CIT's.
- Experience in backcountry guiding and tripping is an asset.
- PMBI – Mountain Bike Instructor L1, 2, or 3 is an asset

As a condition of employment, a valid Police Records Check (for working with the Vulnerable Sector) completed within the last 6 months is required prior to commencing work.
